Overall good water quality - Cold /Cool Water System

- Fish Diversity 42 species downstream of dam -37 native species; 4 salmonid species
 - Native Species Smallmouth bass, walleyes, suckers (white, northern hog, shorthead redhorse, golden redhorse)
 - 4 salmonid species (rainbow trout, Chinook, coho, brown trout)

THE DOWAGIAC CREEK (RIVER)

A meeting of citizens took place on November 22, 1874, to hear a report from the engineers engaged to survey the "Dowagiac Swamp" and to consider plans for draining it. This swamp covered a large area and extended from Dowagiac about twelve miles north and west toward Decatur. (M-51 North of Dowagiac cuts across this "swamp.") (Many years ago this area was a hideout for thieves, robbers and highwaymen.) This road was previously known as North Town Line Swamp Road and over two miles of it was of corduroy construction.

The original survey was concerned with Decatur and Hamilton T Buren County and Wayne and Silver Creek Townships in Cass County that if the "swamp" could be drained that the land could be more pro grow corn and grass(hay).
